Dear Valley View Families!

It is with great pleasure I welcome you back to school or to Valley View for the first time! Hopefully, you have thoroughly enjoyed your family time this past summer and are ready to deliver the children to us. As the Rocklin community continues to grow, so does our great school. For those of you who are new to us, we are excited to meet you and welcome you into our big family. Again this year, we have added 2 more classes to prepare for the growth. You can meet all of our wonderful teachers at 'Meet the Teacher' day next week.

This year we will be in our 2nd year of the English language arts curriculum, 4th year of our math for K-5th, and 5th year for 6th grade. As expected, time and experience delving into each has made everyone comfortable with the many rigorous changes in education. Our teachers participate in ongoing professional development before school begins, as well as throughout the year. We strive to continually improve with effective teaching and learning practices.

GOOGLE - We are a Google district! Gmail, Calendar, Docs, Slides, and much more! All staff use Gmail accounts for email correspondence. CAASSP (CA Assessment of Student Performance & Progress) test scores which measure students' knowledge and skills towards the college and career standards will be sent to your home from our district office, if not already (for last year's students in grades 3-6). Staff spends time analyzing the data to learn about our successes and any areas in need of additional focus regarding both teaching and learning.

PARENT PORTAL - Please log into your <u>Parent Portal</u> account to electronically update and confirm your information. Here are <u>Student Data Confirmation Instructions</u> and <u>Login or Reset Password Instructions</u>. If you need additional assistance with this process, you may stop by the office on Thursday or Friday of this week between 7:15-3:45 (office closed for lunch 12:00-1:00 on Friday).

CLASS LISTS - Due to recently passed privacy law, we are no longer able to post class rosters in a public setting. This means we will not be posting rosters outside the office as done in the past. Instead, beginning at 4:00pm on Friday, August 10th, all parents who have successfully logged in to their parent portal and confirmed their 2018-2019 data will be able to see who their children have as their teacher. We realize this is a change from previous years and appreciate your understanding of this decision to protect student information and confidentiality. Please see the recent email you received from Rocklin Unified District Leadership for instructions on how to "confirm data" through the Parent Portal.

SAFETY FIRST - PLEASE READ & FOLLOW THESE RULES! Our parking lots and crosswalks will be very crowded the first few weeks. We will have more students, parents and cars throughout the year as well. Let's make a concerted effort to safely deliver students to school. I highly encourage you to walk to school or parking on the street and walking your student up to school if you want. Here are some important reminders about our simple rules.

- 1) The <u>upper, small lot is for Kinder drop off/pick up only</u>. You must have a permit to pick up a kindergartener in this lot. Permits will be issued to kindergarten families at 'Meet the Teacher' Day. The lower, big lot is for all other students.
- 2) In both lots, patiently wait in the 'car line' for your student. Even if there is an open space ahead, please wait in line for cars to pull forward.

3) Be courteous and cautious. Again this year, our diligent Rocklin Police Department is helping us by regularly visiting and monitoring the safety of all. Please abide by our rules even when police are not present.

Please be cognizant of the colored curbs, red/yellow, and follow the applicable loading/no parking laws. The City asked that I remind you <u>not</u> to park your cars there or you can be cited. Also the Springfield community has asked that we not block the entrances to their neighborhoods. THANK YOU in advance for helping to make our school community a safe place for all!
